

How to reach ICAR-CIFRI

Barrackpore is located in North 24-Parganas District, 24 Km. away from Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose air port and Howrah Rly. Stn., and 22 Km away from Sealdah/ Kolkata Rly Stn. ICAR-Central Inland Fisheries Research Institute is located at Monirampur, 5 Km. away from Barrackpore Rly Stn. on Sealdah Main Rly. section. One can reach also from Howrah Rly. Stn., alighting at Sheoraphuly Rly Stn. (on Howrah-Burdwan Main Section) and then by crossing the Hooghlyriver by ferry at Sheoraphuli ghat (alias Du paisa ghat) to Manirampur and walk to the campus.
